Combustible Trash

● Target for Combustible Household Waste Reduction: 300 g per person/day (Put your trash out between 6:00 AM to 8:00 AM on collection day)

○ Write your name on the designated combustible trash bag, then put in the collection site. Always use the designated bag.

Kitchen Waste

- Leftover
- Vegetable Scraps

Drain well before throwing out.
○ Please process kitchen waste at home to the extent possible.

Subsidies are available for the purchase of compost bins and electric garbage disposers.
*Excludes recyclable items.

Paper Scraps

- Paper Scraps
- Tissue Paper
- Unrecyclable Paper

Leather/Rubber

- Bags
- Shoes

Plants/Grass

50 cm or shorter

Bundles of 30 cm or less

Branches 10 cm thick or less, label with a name tag, etc. Bundle together and label with your name, then put at the collection site as is. (Up to 3 bundles at once)

○ Remove incombustible trash from bags and put in the "Incombustible Trash Container".

Incombustible Trash Container

Never place spray cans or containers with hazardous or toxic materials inside the Incombustible Trash Container.

Container Collection Day

Bulky Waste

○ Do not put out hazardous household goods containing asbestos.

○ Separate bulky waste into Combustible Bulky Waste/Wooden Furniture and Incombustible Bulky Waste at the bulky waste collection site.

◆ The dimensions should be within 80 cm in height, 60 cm in width, and 3 meters in length.

Home Appliances That Are Not Collected

Take the following 6 items back to the retailer you purchased them from or, if purchasing a new item, to the new dealer. (Not collected by the town)

- Refrigerators
- Freezers
- TVs
- Washing Machines
- Air Conditioners
- Dryers

Oversized garbage and wooden furniture to burn

- Bedding
- Rugs
- Carpets
- Mattresses (Without Springs)
- Reed Screens
- Wooden Furniture (Chairs, Desks, Chests, etc.)

*Remove metal, glass, and mirrors from wooden furniture.

Incombustible Bulky Waste

- Bicycles
- Umbrellas
- Vacuum
- Cleaners
- Steel Products (Chairs, Desks, Shelves, etc.)
- Computers
- Skis/Snowboards
- Plastic Buckets

Wash inside	*Dispose of bottles that can be used repeatedly, such as beer bottles and sake bottles, at collection sites at stores or schools whenever possible.
Paper	● Newspapers, Flyers in Newspapers ● Magazines ● Cardboard	1. Remove vinyl and metal 2. Separate by category 3. Bundle together and tie using a parcel knot to make it easy to carry. Bundles of cardboard should be no larger than 1 meter in length and width.	*CDs and DVDs inside magazines → Other Plastics
Paper Drink Cartons	● Paper Drink Cartons	1. Wash inside 2. Cut along the sides 3. Dry	*Packs with aluminum coating on the inside → Combustible trash
Other Paper	● Other Paper	1. Bundle together using a parcel knot to make it easy to carry. 2. Put small items in a paper bag, then bundle the bag with twine using a parcel knot when full.	*Do not mix with items other than those made of paper: Clips, Metal, Vinyl, etc. *Thermal paper, window envelopes, waterproof paper, photographs and other compound paper containing other materials, heavily soiled or wet items → Combustible Waste
Cloth	● Old Clothes/Cloth	1. Launder 2. Dry 3. Bundle using a parcel knot	*Socks, belts, gloves, hats, sweaters, materials padded with cotton, and soiled items → Combustible Waste *Rugs and carpets → Bulky Waste
Cans	● Aluminum Cans ● Steel Cans ● Spray Cans	1. Wash the inside of the food or drink can 2. Put the lid with the can 3. Do not crush the can 4. Make sure the spray can is empty; there is no need to poke holes in it.	*Dirty or crushed cans → Incombustible Trash *Standalone can lids or pull tops → Incombustible Trash
PET Bottles	● PET Bottles	1. Remove the cap, label, and handle 2. Wash inside 3. Dry	*Containers made of vinyl chloride (PVC) such as seasonings, oil, detergent, shampoo, etc. → Plastic Containers and Packaging
Plastics	● Plastic Containers and Packaging ● Styrofoam Tray (for Food) ● Other Plastics	1. Use up contents, remove any grime, and rinse with water 2. Dry 3. Dry	*Extremely dirty objects or objects that cannot be cleaned → Combustible Trash *Large items such as buckets and wash basins → Bulky Waste
Fluorescent Tubes & Mercury Thermometers	● Fluorescent Tubes & Mercury Thermometers	These contain mercury, which is hazardous; place in the case you received when purchasing the item. If you do not have the case, wrap in newspaper so it does not break.	*Broken fluorescent tubes → Incombustible Trash
Dry Cell Batteries	● Dry Cell Batteries	Place loose inside the collection container at the collection site. Remove and dispose of single-use or rechargeable batteries in small household appliances. Place vinyl tape over the electrodes of rechargeable batteries to insulate them before placing in the collection site.	*Portable battery generators → Incombustible Bulky Waste
Tempura Oil (Used Food Oil)	● Tempura Oil (Used Food Oil)	1. Remove any remaining batter or lard 2. Transfer to an appropriate container, such as an empty glass or plastic bottle	*Put out containers used for storing household items with → Combustible Trash

There are special collection containers for each of these at collection sites in each district.
